This will be our sixth visit to Thorpe Woodlands which is run by Suffolk Outdoor Education. The children will be staying at the the fully accessible centre which is perfectly situated for a wide range of land and water-based outdoor activities, and offers a superb environment in which young people and adults can learn, develop and have an amazing amount of FUN! Over the years we have received extremely positive feedback and praise from participating pupils (and their parents) for an action-packed, exciting and informative residential week. Please note that you will be required to pay on time at the end of each month unless you have contacted the school and other arrangements have been made.
