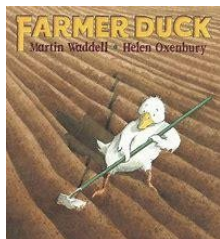

We will also continue to look at the 2x, 5x, 10x and 3x tables (3x year 2 only). Directional language will also be a focus - to help with this please talk to your child about left and right and as you walk around talk about the turns you are making.
